


Holywell Walk 1

St Beuno's and St Winefrides Well

1.75 miles/2.7kms



- 1 Starting from the Clock in the Centre of the High Street. Walk up the street and turn left into Tower Gardens. Walk through and down the steps to the subway and into the Car Park. Cross directly over to enter the Greenfield Valley Heritage Park. Walk down under the bridge and along the former railway line
- 2 When the track widens out, turn sharply left to go almost parallel and to a barrier and gap. Continue down to the road and turn left to St Winefride's Well.

(After visiting the shrine (small charge) cross over the road into the small car park. In the corner there are a series of steps. These lead quite steeply to the top of the hill. Here you will find the remains of St Beuno's Well)

- 3 After visiting the Wells leave the car park and turn left along the track. This is known locally as The Gowdal. When the track turns sharply right, towards the farm house, turn left uphill and through a kissing gate.

- 4 When you come to a crossing of tracks turn left. You are now walking below the houses. Continue to the road. Walk past the Fire Station and down the road to the Pedestrian Crossing. Go left and then right to return to the start.

Much of the walk is suitable for mobility scooters. The route through Tower Gardens and down the slope, through the car park and to the Heritage Park is either flat or graded. It then becomes steeper to the bridge. The route is then level to the Well.

From here there are two alternatives:

- (a) return the way you came:
- (b) go up past the Parish Church of St James.
