


WALK 5

TWO WOODS AND THE COAST
5 miles/ 8 km

- 1 Start from the Town Clock and walk up the High Street to cross the Bus Station via the pedestrian crossings. Turn left and walk past the Supermarket. Continue up Penymaes Road to pass the Windmill. Turn left at the cross roads and then left again along Nant y Coed. Follow this road to its end.
- 2 Enter Penymaes Wood. After passing the notice board, and before you reach the exit, turn left along a woodland path. Follow this path which eventually becomes waymarked downhill to the stream. After crossing the footbridge follow the path as it goes left uphill. When you reach the stile on your right cross it into the field and turn right. Go over the stile into the next field.
- 3 Continue down the field towards the farmhouse and go over another stile. Go diagonally right past the electricity pole to a stile. Cross over it and then diagonally left to go over the stile to the track. Turn right down to the road - A 548.
- 4 Cross over and turn right. Walk alongside this busy road to the roundabout. Turn left and go over the railway bridge. Go

ahead at the junction and to the end of the road at the Recycling Centre. Go left to join the Coast Path. Turn left to follow it then right at the next crossing point to join the tarmac path. Follow to Greenfield Dock.

- 5 Turn left uphill over the railway line to the A 548 once more. Taking care crossing the road to go to the road going left to the Car Park. Walk through the car park and up past Basingwerk Abbey to the Greenfield Valley Visitor Centre.



- 6 Turn left just before the former Spring Gardens School which was brought down from its original site in Holywell. Continue through the gate on to the tarmac road and immediately fork left slightly uphill. On your right is the stream which originates at St Winefride's Well. At the reservoir take the path that goes ahead towards the picnic area. Follow this path to the low remains of a factory chimney. Go up the steps to the dam. Turn left and immediately right you are now on the former railway line. Return to the Town Centre.
