


WALK 9

STOKYN AND THE COAST PATH

6 miles/9 kms

1 Starting from the Greenfield Valley Heritage Centre walk up past the old school and to the road. Go left along this road to the reservoir. Take path alongside the reservoir at first and then left to join the disused railway line. At the waymark post take the footpath up right through the bank. Follow the path down to the dam and cross over it. Turn left to the pub and the road at Bryn Celyn.



2 Cross over the main road and walk up the road opposite. Follow this until you come to a gate. Go through it on to a sunken lane. Walk up this and cross over the stile into the field.

3 Go straight ahead towards and through the gap. Walk to the right of the water trough and then bear left to go over a stile in a gate (hidden in the trees). Continue to go over the metal stile. Cross the field towards the trees in the hedge ahead. Cross over the stile and walk with the hedge on your right to another stile. Walk along the farm track to another stile. You are now at the back of Stokyn Hall.

4 Cross over the stile and then down the field. Cross over the next stile and walk down to

go over the footbridge and up the other side to the road. Turn right and then take the footpath on your left. Cross over into the field to go over a stile a little further on from the gate on your right. Cross the next field by heading for the pole and then to a footbridge. In the next field keep the fence to your left to reach another stile. Turn right and follow the Bridleway down to the Hen Dafarn.

5 Use the Pedestrian Crossing and return to the stream. Walk to the right of it - behind the market stalls. You are now on the Coast Path. Follow to Greenfield Dock.

6 Continue up and over the bridge over the railway to the main road. Cross over the A548 and go left and right to the Car Park opposite. Walk through and back into the Heritage Park.
